

**McAfee Site Advisor Enterprise Plus ("ESAP")****ESAP-3.0.x****Quickstart Scope Definition Guidelines**

McAfee® SiteAdvisor® Enterprise Plus ("ESAP") is a browser protection solution that can be deployed and managed by using McAfee ePolicy Orchestrator® 4.x.x. The client software runs on managed systems to protect users from threats they encounter while searching and browsing websites with Internet Explorer or Firefox or downloading files with Internet Explorer. SiteAdvisor Enterprise Plus is integrated with McAfee advanced protection solutions. Get the appropriate service type below to ensure it is implemented and configured fast, cost-effectively and securely.

New Installation: 1 X MD-QS-SMB-4HR*

A McAfee Subject Matter Expert ("SME") will remotely configure and deploy ESAP based on McAfee's Best Practices.

- Review server and software requirements
- Install and Configure ESAP from the ePO Server:
 - Install the ESAP Extension
 - Install License
 - Add the ESAP deployment package to the ePO Repository
 - Deploy and enable the ESAP Agent to endpoints (up to 5)*
 - Create ESAP policies based on your environment (up to 5)*
- Test the ESAP policies to verify they are working properly.

Upgrading: 1 X MD-QS-SMB-4HR*

McAfee's SME will perform the following tasks:

- Review server and software requirements
- Upgrade and Configure ESAP from the ePO Server:
 - Export current ESAP policies
 - Install the latest ESAP extension
 - Update the ESAP license
 - Add the latest ESAP deployment package to the ePO Repository
 - Install and enable the new ESAP Agent on endpoints (up to 5)*
 - Import and Modify ESAP policies (up to 5)*
- Test the ESAP policies to verify proper operation.

Optimization: 1 X MD-QS-SMB-4HR*

McAfee's SME will perform the following tasks:

- Verify the ESAP software functions as expected.
- ESAP Features:
 - Provides safety ratings for sites visited
 - Support multiple browsers and search engines

- ESAP Framework:
 - Advanced warning on web sites that may house threat
- ESAP Categories:
 - Malware
 - Adware
 - Spyware
 - Viruses
 - Phishing scams
- Review current ESAP policies for compliance with McAfee Best Practices (up to 5)*
- Validate ESAP Policy Assignment functionality.
- Confirm availability of ESAP queries and dashboards.

Knowledge Transfer: 1 X MD-QS-SMB-4HR*

McAfee's SME will perform the following tasks:

- Explain the ESAP features:
 - Provides safety ratings for sites visited
 - Support multiple browsers and search engines
- Explain ESAP Framework:
 - Advanced warning on web sites that may house threat
- Explain ESAP Categories:
 - Malware
 - Adware
 - Spyware
 - Viruses
 - Phishing scams
- Explain policy creation and assignment based on the previous uses mentioned (up to 5)*.
- Review the available ESAP queries and dashboards (up to 5)*.

Session Requirements - before getting started: Client's responsibility...

- Functional ePO environment based on McAfee's recommended requirements
- McAfee Agent installed on the servers to be managed by ESAP
- Validate that all endpoints, databases and servers meet McAfee's hardware and software requirements (See Product Guide)
- Validate that all applicable McAfee software licenses have been installed via Client's valid grant number
- Perform necessary backups
- Indicate if there are any outstanding Service Requests/Trouble Tickets opened with McAfee Technical Support
